THAT Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior receive the Call to Action concerning the Syrian refugee Crisis from Association of Municipalities of Ontario, dated September 9, 2015;

WHEREAS Syria’s civil war has been described as the worst humanitarian disaster of our time, with millions of refugees having been displaced from their country thus far;

AND WHEREAS a Syria refugee crisis has developed, and a need for global response is imminent;

AND WHEREAS AMO is challenging all of its member municipalities to donate at least \$100 to aid in the international effort to resettle the Syrian refugees in safe countries, with a goal of raising a minimum of \$40,000;

AND WHEREAS AMO will donate all of the proceeds to Lifeline Syria, an organization seeking to resettle and integrate 1,000 Syrian refugees in Ontario over the next two years, reuniting them with their families;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior support the “Syrian Refugee Crisis” by donating \$1000 to the AMO cause, from the Council Contingency Grants Operating Account 1-5-7600-6999.
