## Town Hall Business Continuation during Construction

Downtown Revitalization construction will be taking place along Elgin Street West in front of Town Hall from May – October. Town Hall will **remain open for business** Monday through Friday between 8:30 am – 4:30 pm at 105 Elgin Street West. Short term visitor parking will be available along Madawaska Street behind the Town Hall during construction and an accessible path of travel and entrance to Town Hall will always be maintained. All Council/Committee Meetings between May 1 and October 15<sup>th</sup> will held at **the Stanley Tourangeau Fire/Police Services Centre** located at 67 Meehan Street.

## Daniel Street Construction

Please note that there will be lane reductions on Daniel Street between Michael Street and Charles Street from April 24<sup>th</sup> – July 31<sup>st</sup>. Two lanes of traffic will remain with periodic interruptions to north bound traffic.

## Fire Master Plan Public Meeting

The Town of Arnprior will be completing a comprehensive Fire Master Plan. The Town has retained Performance Concepts to undertake the preparation of a Fire Master Plan which will include a review of such things as administration and compensation, firefighter training, fire prevention and fire safety education, emergency response, apparatus and equipment, and communications. The Fire Master Plan will be developed based on stakeholder and public input, community needs as well as current legislative and best practices, and will guide the delivery of Fire Department strategies and services into the future.
