 Regular recycle collection for Sec. 4 (Fri) will remain on Dec 26  
 For 2026, Jan 1 waste collection will be on Dec 31

Regular recycling collection occurs on either Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday depending on your location with weekly collection alternating between Plastic/Glass/Metal collection and Paper Fibers/Cardboard collection.

Always put your garbage and recycling out at the curbside no later than 7:30 AM (9:30 AM if located Downtown).  
 The contractor will not return for late set-outs.

### Garbage Collection Requirements

- Maximum of two (2) bags per week, extra bags must be tagged
- Extra bag tags can be purchased at Town Hall for \$3.00 each
- Maximum weight for each bag or container is 50lbs
- Maximum bag size —approximately 26" x 32"
- Maximum container size—approximately 67L
- Oversized bags/containers count as additional bags and must be tagged or will not be collected
- Bulky Items (couches, broken appliances) are not collected curbside and must be taken to the landfill located at 658 River Road, McNab/Braeside. Tipping Fees May Apply

## NOTE: The FoodCycler™ Pilot Program

FoodCycler™ is a countertop unit that converts food waste through a drying and grinding process, into a dry, odorless, nutrient-rich soil amendment.

Following the completion of the first pilot phase, the Town of Arnprior has procured two hundred (200) units which can be purchased on a first-come-first-served basis in-person at Town Hall or the Nick Smith Centre.

**Exclusive subsidized pricing for Arnprior residents:**

- FC-30 (2.5L Capacity) \$500- **\$150 + tax**
- Maestro/Eco 5 (5L Capacity) \$800- **\$300 + tax**
