i) **Support of Double Hatter**

Whereas the International Association of Fire Firefighters (IAFF) constitution prohibits career firefighters from working part-time as a volunteer in another fire department; and

Whereas many Ontario municipalities, including the Town of Arnprior, rely on career firefighters and volunteer firefighters in order to provide fire protection; and

Whereas, there are double hatters, firefighters who work full-time in one community and volunteer for a nominal fee, on their time off, for the Arnprior Fire Department, and

Whereas like many municipalities the Town of Arnprior benefits immensely from the extensive training and expertise double hatters bring to Arnprior’s volunteer fire department; and

Whereas several volunteer firefighters in the province have been charged and some have been convicted by an Ontario Professional Fire Fighter’s Association (OPFFA) jury for their volunteer fire fighting efforts in their own town; and

Whereas the right of individuals to use their free time in service of their community is a fundamental right in a free open and democratic society.

Therefore Be It Resolved That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior strongly encourages the Province of Ontario to revise legislation in regards to their position on double hatters; and

Further Be It Resolved That the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior contribute a \$1000.00 donation through www.gofundme.com (Support our Local Two Hatters) in support of double hatters; and

Further Be It Resolved That this resolution be circulated to the Honourable Kathleen Wynne, Premier of Ontario, The Honourable Marie-France Lalonde, Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services, John Yakabuski, MPP Renfrew-Nipissing-Pembroke, the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) and all municipalities in the County of Renfrew.
