i) Development Charges Funding

Whereas there is growing interest in graphic novels from library users; and

Whereas the Arnprior Public Library Board, at their meeting of September 20th, 2017 passed a resolution requesting the Chief Librarian seek funding in the amount of \$3500.00 for the creation of a new adult graphic novel collection; and

Whereas the Town of Arnprior has collected development charges for the provision of library materials and have maintained them in the Development Charge Reserve Fund for future use; and

Whereas there is sufficient Development Charges funding available for this request; and

Therefore Be It Resolved That Council approve funding in the amount of \$3500, to be funded through Development Charges, for the creation of a new graphic novel collection at the Arnprior Public Library

ii) Bill 148 – On Call Provisions for Volunteer Fire Fighters & Overall Economic Impact of Proposed Legislation

Whereas the Town of Arnprior maintains a highly motivated, efficient and well-trained volunteer fire department; and

Whereas changes proposed to on-call provisions in the Employment Standards Act through Bill 148 are not sustainable and will result in exorbitant municipal tax rate increases in order to maintain a viable volunteer Fire Department in Arnprior; and

Whereas the reality being that many Ontario municipalities will be unable to maintain fire services if this change is enacted; and

Whereas the Town of Arnprior would face municipal rate tax increases of at least 10% to maintain the current volunteer fire fighter complement should these on-call changes proposed by Bill 148 be implemented; and

Whereas the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO) submitted a position paper to the Ontario government specifically requesting the exemption of all municipal volunteer firefighters; and

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Arnprior request that municipal volunteer fire fighters be specifically exempted from the on-call changes proposed by Bill 148; and

That the Town of Arnprior requests that the government of Ontario conduct a full economic impact analysis of Bill 148 to clearly understand the effects of the proposed legislation on businesses and municipalities in Ontario; and

Further That this resolution be circulated to Premier Kathleen Wynne, Minister of Labour Kevin Flynn, the Association of Municipalities of Ontario, MPP, John Yakabuski, and all municipalities in the County of Renfrew.
