“Carbon Monoxide Awareness Week”

- WHEREAS:** Carbon Monoxide, often referred to as the “silent killer” is the leading cause of accidental poisoning deaths in North America;
- AND WHEREAS:** Each year carbon monoxide poisoning proves fatal for many Canadians, and makes many more thousands sick with what they think is the flu;
- AND WHEREAS:** The Ontario Building Code requires the installation of carbon monoxide alarms in homes and other residential buildings built after 2001.
- AND WHEREAS:** This November the Town of Arnprior Fire Prevention Office will be increasing awareness of carbon monoxide hazards at home, school and work;
- AND WHEREAS:** Increasing awareness will reduce the number of preventable deaths that may occur in our community as a result of carbon monoxide poisoning;
- THEREFORE:** I, David Reid, Mayor of Arnprior, do hereby proclaim November 1-7, 2016, as “Carbon Monoxide Awareness Week” in the Town of Arnprior and encourage all residents to participate in the outreach activities planned by the Fire Prevention Office to highlight the simple steps all residents can take to avoid personal tragedy.
