May 7th – 13th, 2017:

“Emergency Preparedness Week”

Whereas: Emergency Preparedness Week is an annual event that takes place each year during the first full week of May; and

Whereas: This initiative has taken place since 1996 and is a collaborative event undertaken by provincial and territorial management organizations in conjunction with Public Safety Canada and other partners; and

Whereas: Emergency Preparedness Week encourages Canadians to take the following three simple steps to become better prepared to face a range of emergencies:

1. Know the Risks
2. Make a Plan
3. Get an Emergency Kit
