With the considerable snowfall that we have experienced this past winter, the Town of Arnprior would like to remind residents that live in low lying areas to stay diligent in ensuring that they are adequately prepared in the event that our community should again be impacted by flooding.

Please consider the following general preparedness strategies as stakeholders continue monitor the situation as we move into spring.

Make a Plan

- Thinking about what you would do in different situations and preparing a plan with every member of your family is the first step to being prepared.

Build a Kit

- Your emergency survival kit should have everything you and your family would need to be safe and take care of yourselves for at least three days immediately following an emergency.

Be Informed

- Different hazards require a different approach for being prepared and knowing how to protect yourself and your family. Learn more about Ontario's hazards, so you can better prepare for them and know what to do to protect yourself. Monitor credible media sources before, during and after a significant event for accurate and up to date messaging.
