Town of Arnprior Splash Pad Opens

Arnprior, ON. The Government of Ontario announced that Stage 2 openings could begin on Friday, June 12th, 2020 with restrictions on gatherings of up to 10 people with social **distancing**. **Public Health Authority's COVID-19** regulations must be followed at all Town facilities and we encourage the use of precautionary measures being recommended by health authorities.

We are happy to advise that the splash pad at Robert Simpson Park will open at 8:00 am on Saturday, June 20th with restrictions. It will remain open from 8 am – 8 pm, 7 days a week this season.

As per the Renfrew County Health Units recommendations residents must follow these restrictions at the splash pad:

- **Prior to visiting the splash pad visitors should use the Ministry's online COVID-19 self-assessment tool to self-monitor.**
- Visitors displaying symptoms or who have come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 symptoms, should not visit the splash pad.
- Visitors should bring alcohol-based hand sanitizer (at least 70% alcohol) and disinfectant wipes with them to sanitize hands. Washrooms are not open at this time.
- The maximum occupancy for the splash pad at any given time is 10 people. Please be respectful of the time and share the space with other users to ensure equal and safe use for all.
- Park amenities are available for use at your own risk and are not regularly sanitized.
- Practice physical distancing with those outside your social circle (stay 2 meter/6 feet apart)

While the beach has passed water quality testing by the Renfrew County Health Unit, please be advised that the beach and washrooms will open shortly once Public Health guidelines can be implemented.

Other facilities, such as the Arnprior and District Museum, the Nick Smith Centre Pool and Community Hall are being reviewed and further announcements will be made on these facilities at a later date.
