**Town of Arnprior Closures Amid Provincial Lockdown**

**Arnprior, ON.** The Province of Ontario announced a province wide shutdown beginning Saturday, December 26<sup>th</sup> at 12:01 am. Residents are encouraged to follow the guidance and protocols of our local experts in Public Health. The Town is taking further actions to help protect the health of our community and prevent the spread of the virus.

Effective at 4:30 pm, Wednesday December 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 until January 25<sup>th</sup>, 2021 the following closures will be in effect: Town Hall will be open by appointment only during regular hours for essential services such as landfill vouchers, payments and licenses. Please call 613-623-4231 to schedule an appointment. A reminder that Town Hall is closed December 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup>, 31<sup>st</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup> for the holidays.

The Nick Smith Centre, the Arnprior and District Museum, the Stanley Tourangeau Fire Services Building will be closed to the public. The Arnprior Library will be closed to the public but curbside pickup will be available.

The landfill will remain open with social distancing in place. Vouchers can be purchased at the Nick Smith Centre and Town Hall until close on December 23<sup>rd</sup> and then by appointment at Town Hall starting at 8:30 am on December 29<sup>th</sup>. At this time, we have been advised by our garbage/recycling contractors that there are no anticipated impacts to curbside collection activities.

All programming including public swimming, indoor skating, drop-in programs, and program registration is cancelled. Outdoor rinks will remain open for social distance skating depending on weather conditions.

Even though the facilities are closed to the public, all essential services continue to be offered and all departments are open for business. Please contact staff by phone or email, contact information can be found on the Town of Arnprior website's [contact us page](#). Council will continue to meet virtually so Council meetings are not effected by the facility closure.

For any payments owing to the Town, options include online or telephone banking, mailing a cheque to the Town Hall or dropping a payment off in the secure mail slot at Town Hall located at 105 Elgin Street West. We encourage residents to use these means of payment if at all possible.

If you or a family member suspect you have symptoms of COVID-19, please self-isolate and contact the Renfrew County Virtual Triage and Assessment Centre at 1-844-727-6404 soon as possible.

Town of Arnprior and the Emergency Management Team continues to work closely with the Renfrew County Health Unit and community partners to monitor the COVID-19 virus and respond appropriately.
